The primary purpose of roadside vegetation control in Ocean Shores is to prevent pavement breakup by invasive plants. The secondary purpose of this work is to ensure surface water can drain away from the travel lanes.

Project Schedule:

Physical work is scheduled for the week of May 20, 2019. This activity is extremely weather dependent. In the event the work cannot be conducted consistent with the schedule, the work will be delayed until there is an appropriate weather window.

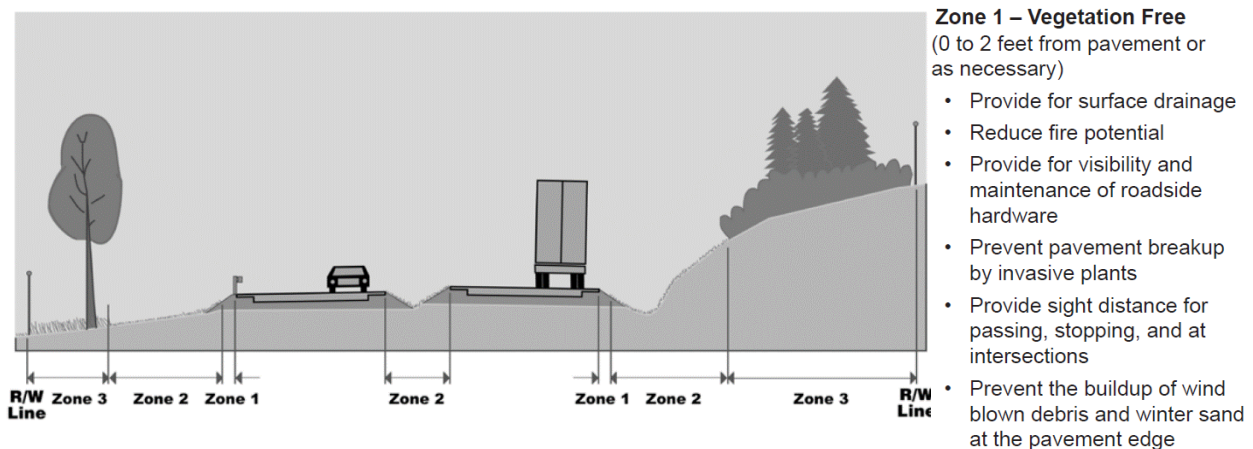
Product Information:
