The city of Ocean Shores Washington is 1 ½ hours west of Olympia Washington and is located right on the Pacific Ocean. Ocean Shores is nationally known for having an excellent atmosphere for relaxation, maintaining an excellent quality of life, a low crime rate, and a fantastic area for fishing and hunting. THE DEPARTMENT:

These hiring's exhausted the list of candidates available; this testing process will be to establish a list of eligible candidates for filling vacancies over the next 12 to 24 months. The Ocean Shores Fire Department is a progressive department dedicated to the safety of the people we serve. We provide services in fire suppression, emergency medical services, (advanced life support), rescue services, fire prevention, hazardous materials, public education, and disaster mitigation. We are a combination career/volunteer department. Ocean Shores Fire Department provides service for the City of Ocean Shores and the North Beach area. We currently have 4 ambulances, 3 engines, 1 ladder truck, and 2 brush trucks. We respond out of two fire stations with our primary crews working an A, B, C shift on a 48/96 schedule. The Ocean Shores Fire Department ran 2044 calls in 2014 and average 6 alarms per day in 2015
