Two men are in custody at Grays Harbor County Jail after being arrested for a series of vehicle prowls over the weekend. A 19-year old Ocean Shores man and an 18-year-old Mukilteo man were arrested early Saturday morning on suspicion of breaking into at least eight cars in the southeast area of Ocean Shores.

Sergeant Joe Brouillard and Officers Jeff Elmore and Jeff Weiss responded to the area of the 500 block of Quinault Ave. SE on the report of two subjects attempting to break into a car. The officers located several cars in the area that appeared to have been entered and searched through. Two individuals were located nearby that matched the description provided by a witness and were found to be in possession of property taken from one of the vehicles. Ocean Shores Police are continuing to look for any further victims. Both suspects were arrested and are being held on \$5000 bail for eight counts of vehicle prowl.
