A 37-year-old Algona man reported that 2-4 individuals robbed him early in the morning on January 1st. The victim, who had been visiting Ocean Shores, reported that he had gone for a walk around 2:30 in the morning after an argument with his girlfriend. The victim called police around 5:30 am to report that he had been given a ride by several male subjects in a white vehicle and believes that he was hit in the head. He woke up dazed and confused on the side of the road at the south end of Ocean Shores with money missing from his wallet. Ocean Shores Fire personnel transported the victim to Grays Harbor Community Hospital for evaluation and the victim was subsequently airlifted to Harbor View Medical Center. Exact extent of injuries are unknown.
